Maths:

















In week 6 Pod 3 A, B & C held their annual science fair to celebrate science week. They invited the staff and other classes to come along and see the projects they have been working on.
















CUBBY LAND VILLAGE OPENING

Jack Cooney who is our creek monitor, Jack turns the water on and off each day so all our students can enjoy it.




