<u>PAT testing in Reading and Maths</u> is currently happening with all Foundation to Year 7 students during weeks 7-10 of this term. We are also requesting that the Year 3 to Year 7's do the Vocabulary test, as this will provide us with some data for our Site Improvement Plan goal of improving student writing.

<u>NAPLAN</u> We have been informed that NAPLAN results should be provided to schools between the 16th to 27th of September. Just a reminder that next year we will be completing Naplan online. The Year 3's will be doing the Writing on paper, but Year 5's and Year 7's will be doing Writing online. To support your child in improving their keyboard skills, any practice that you can provide at home would be appreciated.








RETIREMENT OF MR ALF D'ARSIE




SPORTS DAY NEWS UPDATE
