In 2021 we will achieve 35% of Year 5 and 7 students in High Bands in NAPLAN. PAT Maths Year 5 & 7 over 40% in High Bands. We used the following scale scores to determine High Band achievement in Maths; Year 5- 132, Year 7-145.	In 2021 increase achievement by a further 10% in Vocabulary, Sentence structure and punctuation criteria in Years 3, 5 and 7 NAPLAN- Increase achievement in the high bands; we will aim to increase to over 20% for Year 5 and 7students.

If we design tasks in Maths to focus on the proficiencies, then we will increase the number of students achieving in the higher bands in NAPLAN numeracy.	If we teach writing with a focus on developing skills of vocabulary, text structure, punctuation choices and sentence structure, we will increase student achievement in writing.
Actions	Actions
 Teachers will design and implement tasks that are differentiated and targeted for identified high band students using the proficiencies of Maths Teachers extend knowledge around addressing misconceptions and plan appropriate intervention for students. Teachers will plan using the DfE's Curriculum Resources. Teachers will trial DfE's units of work as their year level becomes available. Maths equipment to be audited and purchased by teachers to support the teaching of Maths. Could be done collaboratively as a teaching team. Teachers will continue to implement the Golden Way Assessment for Learning agreement to use feedback to drive learning. 	 Teachers will design and implement writing tasks that focus on the transfer of vocabulary, sentence structure and functional grammar. Implement the Seven Steps writing program to develop vocabulary and text structure. Include daily writing through the use of Seven Steps which supports text structure and vocabulary. KFPS 'Writing- Agreed Practices" document collaboratively created and implemented strategies through the Writing Team's leadership. Teachers will plan using the DfE's Curriculum Resources.
