FROM THE PRINCIPAL

As you have probably seen, our **Outdoor Learning Area** is very close to completion. When it is completed, the fence will remain in place for a couple of weeks to enable the turf to settle before students walk on it. (see progress photos on page 4)

Everyone is very excited about using it and we will have an official opening as soon as we are able to.

Retaining Walls: We have been informed by the DfE, that work will finally commence to replace our retaining walls in 2023.

On Track Evaluation In September, our school worked with the External School Review team to analyse how we are tracking against the 3 directions that our school is working towards. The outcome was very positive, as can be seen by the feedback below.

During the on-track evaluation the panel was provided with detailed documentation of strategic planning, the processes and practices for implementation and a variety of examples of how impact is being measured. Through the panel processes staff, students and parents were able to confirm their actions in each of the directions and how teaching and learning had been improved. Classroom visits provided additional evidence of consistency of practice across the school. The school should be commended on the change in culture resulting in greater collaboration, improvement to student learning outcomes and the achievements in each direction over a relatively short period of time.

Pupil Free Day This Friday, the 4th of November, teachers will spend the day analysing our student data and working in teams to plan for improvement. Looking forward to continuing our work to support our students to achieve their best.



Absences

It is a requirement for us to log the reason for your child's absence. If you contact the school as early as possible to let us know that your child will be absent (via phone or text) we ask that you provide the reason. This does not need to go into great detail, it can be as simple as family reasons or illness. If a reason is not provided they will be marked as an unexplained absence and a text message will be sent. This is also to make sure you are aware of the absence. If there is no response to the text message the class teacher will make contact with the family.

Partial Absences

If your child has an appointment and is going to be late or needs to leave early, we require a parent or authorised adult to accompany the child to the front office to sign them in or out. This is the same for picking a child up from the sickroom.

Exemption Forms

If your child is going to be away from school for 3 days or more (eg: family holiday etc) you will need to fill in and return an exemption form (one for each child). This form must be approved by the Principal prior to the dates required and once approved the form will be kept in your child's file.

Please feel free to contact our office staff if you have any questions or require a form to be sent home.


