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FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Year 7's in High School from Term 1, 2022

This means that from 2022, year 6 will be the last year of primary school and year 7 will be the first year of high school.

We have found that some families are becoming anxious about whether their children will have a place in a local high school if they are out of zone.

This anxiety is causing some parents to make the decision to take their child out of Primary school now, even if their child is in Year 3 or 4, to enrol in The Heights or private schools to guarantee a place.

Today I had a conversation with the principal of The Heights, and he was quite surprised by this anxiety and said that while it can't be guaranteed, there is every likelihood that students will be able to enrol for Year 7 in the years to come, even if they are out of zone. He said that he would especially look after students from the current feeder schools, which includes Keithcot Farm Primary School.

I wanted to convey that message, as it is beneficial for students to complete their schooling and graduate from the Primary School where they have formed close relationships and connection. If you are concerned, please have a conversation with the leadership team at The Heights.

Pod 3D Maker's Empire




Maker's Empire is an application available on Windows and iPad that allows students to create and print in 3D. Students in year 6 and 7 have been using *Design Thinking* to solve real-world problems.

This involves: Empathising, Defining the Problem, Ideating, Prototyping, Testing and Repeating the process to create a 3D printed object (technology) that solves a problem.

Students are solving problems we have in our school Hobby Club, such as spilling paint pots and organising brushes. You can see many parts of the process in these photos, including practising using the app and the early designs students have made.

We will be printing out our designs later this term, allowing students to try their prints in Hobby Club.

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

PARKING AROUND THE SCHOOL CAMPUS

We want all our school community members to be safe during the very busy periods before and after school and we encourage all parents and caregivers to follow all road and parking regulations to keep our community safe.

Please observe the 25km/hr speed limit areas along Wynn Vale Drive and Keithcot Farm Drive.

KFPS parents are NOT to park in the Kings Baptist school, the Keithcot Farm Children's Centre and KFPS school carparks. This includes reversing up the KFCC driveways.

Do NOT park and leave your car in a kiss n drop zones, this prevents the flow of traffic. This applies to Children's Centre families as well. Fines apply if caught.

Please move your car as far forward in the kiss n drop zones to allow the maximum amount of cars in as possible.

Do NOT double park at kiss n drop zones even for a short amount of time.

If you can't fit in to the kiss n drop please do a lap and keep the traffic flowing.

Do NOT call your child out onto the road to enter your vehicle to save a bit of time. This is unsafe and sets the wrong example to all children. The Council will be erecting fences around the roundabout curb sides to restrict this practice.

Have your children use the school crossings at all times rather than running across the road. This is highly dangerous and does not promote road safety practices to your children.






